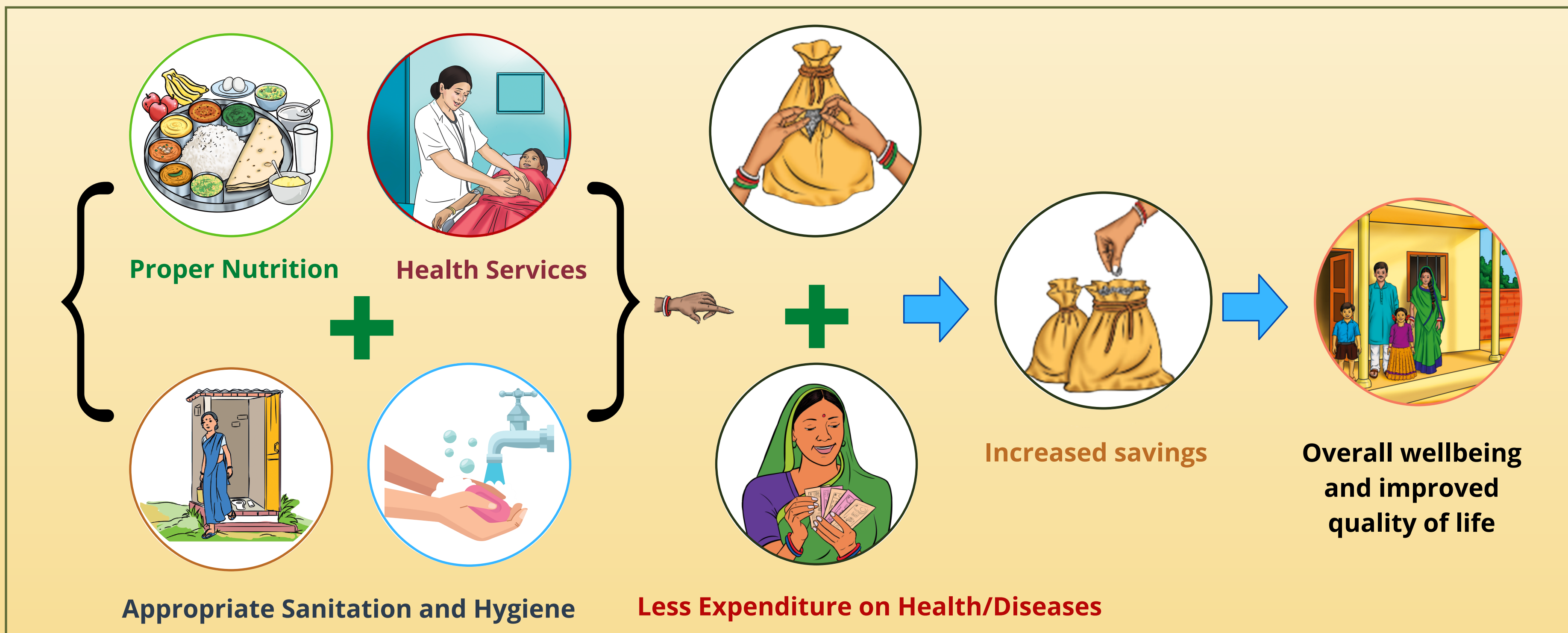

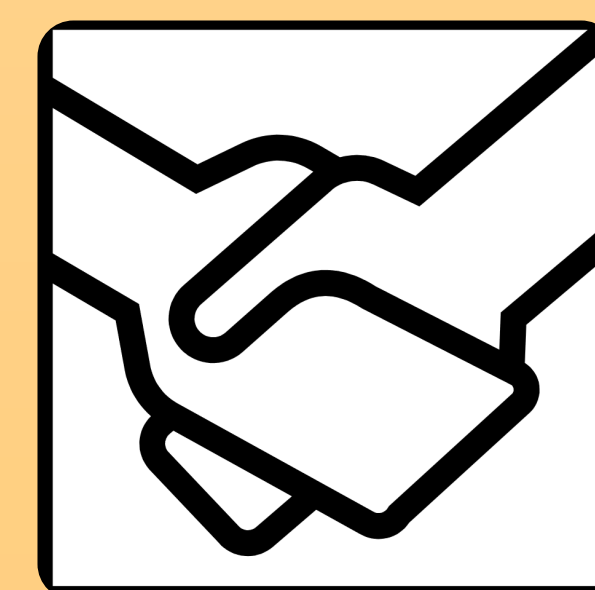

Roles and Responsibilities at VO level

- Develop FNHW Action Plan
- Support FNHW CRP to implement FNHW interventions
 - ◆ Rollout FNHW sessions during monthly meetings
 - ◆ Organize VO level community events/campaigns
 - ◆ Undertake home-visit/peer counselling
 - ◆ Provide support during VHSND
- Mobilize target groups to participate in various FNHW events/activities
- Collate SHG level reports of interventions and report to the CLF Level
- Monitor progress of FNHW activities
- Represent SHG platform in various community forums/committees (VHSNC/Gram Sabhas)
- Coordinate convergence with village-level frontline functionaries (ASHA and AWW) and representatives of line departments (PRI etc.)
- Conduct Vulnerability Reduction Planning including VRF augmentation for SHG beneficiaries
- Support in establishing a reward mechanism
- Participate in POSHAN Abhiyaan-POSHAN Maah/POSHAN Pakhwada and other events

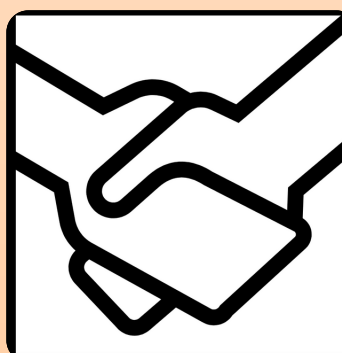




Roles and Responsibilities at CLF level

CLF SAC

- Develop FNHW Action Plan
- Review performance of VO SAC
- Undertake monitoring visits to VO to review FNHW progress
- Meetings with below block level representatives of line departments (ANM, Anganwadi Supervisor, PRI member etc.)
- Support and coordinate for establishment of FNHW enterprises



CLF OB/EC

- Coordinate with BMMU for FNHW related guidance
- Review FNHW activities along with grading of VOs
- Monthly review of FNHW CRP/cadre and release of payment
- Support in establishment of reward mechanism
- Facilitate release, monitor utilization and augmentation of Vulnerability Reduction Fund



Participate in POSHAN Abhiyaan- POSHAN Maah/POSHAN Pakhwada and other events
